

The Margaretta Township Trustees met in regular session on May 19, 2011.

Present were Mr. Pooch and Mr. Riesterer, & Mr. Bias arrived late.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve the minutes, as presented by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley, from the May 5, 2011 meeting. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve and sign warrants 10687-10720, that were presented for payment by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to accept the financial reports that were presented by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Rich Miller was at the meeting to discuss the tiling of his property on Thicket & Heywood Rd. He is planning on tiling the land and he wanted to discuss with the trustees where it would be best for him to run his water. There is a road side tile in the area, but there is also a ditch across the road. There was a discussion and the trustees will look into it further.

Mr. Tom Johnson gave a zoning update. Tom mentioned that Battery Brothers in Crystal Rock has been contacted. This issue is being addressed and they are planning on moving into the building with Fox Cycles. Fox Cycles moved into their new location last Tuesday. Mr. Johnson has been in contact with Bob England in regard to Mr. Fecik's house on Columbus Ave, Crystal Rock, to have it fixed up. Mr. Johnson mentioned that he has had a complaint about some property on Thicket Rd., there is a lot of stuff piled outside.

Tracy Keller was at the meeting. She presented a notice from the Zoning Board that they have recommended several zoning amendments for accessory buildings/structures.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments for accessory buildings/structures on June 16, 2011 at 7 p.m. Vote: all ayes.

Chief Keimer gave a brief report. A guy from Verizon was here today. He is getting a quote together. There was some discussion about going with Verizon or staying with Nextel. Mr. Neill said he likes Nextel. The trustees said we could get a quote from them also. We need to look at what would be best for the township.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to grant Chief Keimer's vacation request for June 8, 9 & 10, 2011. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Jim Neill gave his road/cemetery report. Jim mentioned that a tree limb is hanging over Crystal Rock Rd. Jim will contact the owner of the tree to see if they will take care of it. If not the trustees said that Jim should get it taken care of. Mr. Neill said everything is ready for Memorial Day.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch to purchase a 60 gal sprayer and a 550 gal water tank and valve from GVM for a total cost of \$965.00. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias mentioned that he had attended public records training and that he could also be the designee for the township.

Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann, mentioned that our health insurance renewal will be coming for July. She has forms that can be filled out if the trustees want to get quotes. The trustees said will wait for now. If our renewal looks like it will be large we will fill out the forms so we can compare plans.

Mary Ann said that she just received the bank information from the two new hires, so she will probably have to do a check for their first pay period next week.

Also the total cost from Erie Blacktop was over around \$2000. The trustees were ok with this.

Mary Ann mentioned that Sandusky Register had contacted her on our bill that they said was not paid. We had never received it so they faxed copy to her and she paid it tonight.

A meeting with Crystal Dymond, storm water coordinator will be held on Monday, May 23, 2011.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch to adjourn. Vote: all ayes.
