Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch to approve the financial reports submitted by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all aye

**Jim Neill/Robert Biglin: Road & Cemetery Department:**

Mr. Biglin presented pricing information from Construction Equipment and Tuffman for the storm sewer replacement on Maple Avenue to include mini-excavator rental, catch basins, and pipe.

Mr. Biglin reported that the berm work continues and Maple Avenue is complete.

Mr. Biglin reported that the road mowing continues and the creek areas have been sprayed.

Mr. Biglin requested to cost share the replacement of the hose on the crack sealer with Groton and Oxford Township. Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch to approve the cost sharing with Groton and Oxford Townships not to exceed \$2,700.00 for the new hose. Vote: all aye.
