Present were Mr. Pooch, Mr. Bias and Mr. Riesterer.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Bias to approve the minutes, as presented by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley, from the October 20, 2011 meeting. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch, to approve and sign warrants#11105-11141, that were presented for payments by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Bias to accept the financial reports that were submitted by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes.

Margareta student Tyler Smith was in attendance to observe our meeting.

Chief Mohr gave his monthly report. He said we had a couple of dispatch clinches, but that he is working on it. Chief had information on new lettering for the back of the Fire Station. A quote from Brady was for \$1849 with labor. Chief Mohr gave a vehicle update. The new vehicle proposals were discussed. Everyone was in agreement that we would like to have a new ambulance first and possibly fix up our grass truck. Chief Mohr would like to sell unit 123. He could do it through Fire Tech and they take 10% of the sale. The trustees said to be sure everything is done properly for government sales.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Bias to allow Chief Mohr to sell truck 123 by the best way available to us. Vote: 2 ayes and Mr. Riesterer abstained.

The Trustees asked Chief to be sure the sale is done properly.

There were no zoning or road reports tonight.

The Trustees discussed levy issues.


