

The Margareta Township Trustees met on April 12, 2012 at 7 p.m.

Present were Mr. Bias, Mr. Pooch and Mr. Riesterer.

Mr. Riesterer moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch to approve the minutes from the March 15, 2012 meeting, as presented by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley. Vote: all ayes. The Trustees noted that our purchase from Seal Master that was approved on March 15, 2012, was actually billed by Thor Works, these are the same company.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve and sign warrants #11495-11578 that were presented for payment by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Riesterer moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch to accept the financial reports that were presented by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley. Vote: all ayes.

The Trustees started the meeting with a hearing on the 213 Crystal Rock Rd property. Zoning Inspector Thomas Johnson mentioned that all notifications on this property were sent and that the certified mail had been signed by the parties involved. He said the 30 days have expired and that we can proceed with the demolition of the property. Tom mentioned that the Fire Department would like to use a section of the home for training purposes. After a discussion on this the Trustees said that they could use it as long as it doesn't hold up the demolition and as long as the Firefighters feel its safe enough for the training.

Mr. Riesterer moved, seconded by Mr. Bias, to contract with Shortridge Construction for the demolition on 213 Crystal Rock Road for an amount not to exceed \$6500. Vote: 2 ayes, Mr. Pooch. abstained.

Mr. Riesterer moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch, to close the hearing on 213 Crystal Rock Rd., Vote: all ayes.

Zoning report continued with a discussion on getting together a list of other properties that need to be cleaned up. Mr. Johnson said he has a couple on his current list. Tom mentioned that Erie Blacktop has taken the fence down and they have done a lot of clean up. The Trustees mentioned that it was greatly appreciated and that it is looking good. Tom mentioned that he contacted Tim King about researching zoning commission meetings to see if they need to meet every month if there is no business to be handled. He said that we don't have to meet every month, but he will get a legal opinion on this. Tom had several complaints about zoning issues from Mr. Marzullo. He filled out a form with these complaints.

Chief Mohr gave his report. He has 14 sections of 1 ½" hose that needs to be declared as surplus so that it can be sold. Chief Mohr also mentioned that they are cleaning out the Sheriff's room. The Trustees said to get an estimate on replacing the door and putting in a drop ceiling.

Mr. Riesterer moved, seconded by Mr. Pooch declare 14 sections of 1 ½" hose as surplus and give the Fire Department permission to sell it. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to grant Tom Johnson his vacation request for May 3, 5 & 7 2012. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Jim Neill gave his report. He had a quote from Shearer Equipment for a new gator. Jim also had quote for our mowing from Classic Lawncare and Castalia Trenching. Castalia Trenching does not want to be liable for any property damage that may be done. Jim will be getting together a list of properties that need mowing. For now Mr. Neill would like to hold off hiring any help for the Road Department for the summer. He would like to see if they can handle the summer work without hiring extra help, due to our budget issues. Jim had the contract with Liberty Tire for our tire recycling day on June 2, 2012. A culvert on Heywood Rd needs to be repaired/replaced. ODNR will pay for the culvert replacement; we will need to repair the road after the culvert is replaced. This should be a minimal expense.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to purchase a new John Deere gator for the Cemetery from Shearer for a cost (after trading in our old gator and old Massey Ferguson MF 30) of \$3116.50. Vote: all ayes.

The Trustees mentioned the possibility of a joint project with Perkins Township, Erie County and Margareta Township for fixing Old Railroad from Perkins Ave to Bogart Rd. The Verizon Lease was discussed. We may need a couple of things changed in the agreement that Verizon wants to implement.

The CDBG Block Grant is due April 30, 2012

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to adjourn. Vote: all ayes.
